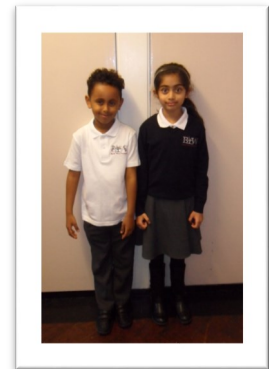
Full school uniform

All children should be in full school uniform:-

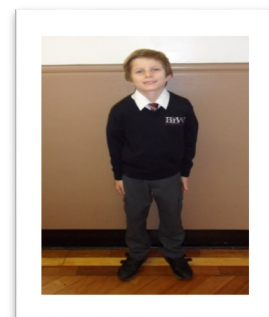
Our uniform comprises of:-
