I would like to share with you the successes of last year. We had a very successful year with the school attaining the following results at the end of KS2:-

- ◆ Reading 52%
- ◆ Writing 74%
- ◆ Maths 79%
- ◆ EGPS 85%
- ◆ R/W/M 50%

The writing was in line with National data, whilst the maths and EGPS was significantly higher. Well done to the hard work and dedication of all the staff and pupils.

The key priorities for this year are to build on last years achievements by:-

- ◆ increasing the amount of progress made by all children
- ◆ being in line with national attainment measures in all areas
- ◆ having an exciting curriculum to enthuse and motivate all children
- ◆ achieving our target of 96% for attendance
- ◆ ensuring all children improve their behaviours for learning


I am sure with your support, we will be able to achieve all these targets.
